



Packers Hall of Fame & Lambeau Field Stadium Tours

Group Sales Policies

GROUP PRICING

Groups must pay for at least twenty (20) attendees to qualify for a privately booked Stadium Tour and receive the group rate for the Hall of Fame and Stadium Tours. Groups booking on home game weekends are subject to the public pricing model and policies.

Stadium Tours can accommodate up to 35 attendees per tour. Groups with over 35 attendees need to arrange additional tour times prior to the event date. Groups arriving on the event date with over 35 attendees may not be accommodated for the additional guests.

INVOICE AND PAYMENT

Final confirmation of the visit date/time, numbers, and payment MUST be received at least ten (10) business days prior to the event date. Payments can be made over the phone or by check. Checks should be made payable to the Green Bay Packers. Tickets are non-refundable, non-transferable and not for resale.

If you are a tax-exempt organization, please email a copy of your WI Sales and Use Certificate of Exempt Status (CES). This form must be on file prior to the payment deadline in order to apply.

Please note that Lambeau Field, including the Packers Hall of Fame, Packers Pro Shop and 1919 Kitchen & Tap, is cashless.

PARKING INFORMATION

We recommend parking in [Lot 4](#), located off of Lombardi Avenue on the east side of the stadium.

If you will be arriving by bus or motorcoach, your group can be dropped off near the entrance to the American Family Insurance Gate. Your driver should park at the northeast corner of Lot 4, near the intersection of Lombardi Avenue and Oneida Street.

BUILDING ENTRANCE

Groups should enter the stadium through the American Family Insurance Gate, on the east side of the stadium. The giant Lombardi Trophy is a good indicator you are in the correct spot. Once inside, the group leader should check in at the Hall of Fame desk, located on the first floor of the Lambeau Field Atrium. The rest of the group can proceed to their designated meeting point.

Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the time of your first scheduled experience, as tours leave promptly at their scheduled time. If your group is delayed, the tour will still end at its scheduled time.

Stadium Tours will, typically, meet on the first floor of the Lambeau Field Atrium, unless otherwise directed. Groups should meet at the sign for their designated tour type.

VISITOR GUIDELINES

Food and beverages are not allowed in the Packers Hall of Fame or on Lambeau Field Stadium Tours.

Personal belongings should stay with your group or in your vehicle/bus. The Hall of Fame and Guest services cannot hold these items and are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Still photos are encouraged, but the use of video or audio recording is prohibited.

The stadium, including the Hall of Fame, is open to the public, please be considerate of other guests.

ACCESSIBILITY

The Hall of Fame and all Stadium Tours are wheelchair accessible. A limited number of wheelchairs are available at the Atrium Guest Services desk. In order to use a Lambeau Field issued wheelchair, a photo ID is required to be kept on file while the chair is in use. Hall of Fame and Stadium Tour staff are not permitted to assist with wheelchair mobility.

Accommodation for individuals with hearing and/or visual impairment should be requested with at least 24 hours' notice.

All Hall of fame video content also includes closed captioning.

Lambeau Field follows the Green Bay city ordinance regarding animals in public spaces. Therefore, only service animals are welcome.

CATERING

Catering options are provided through the Packers catering partner, Delaware North. Catering must be requested at least three (3) weeks prior to the visit date. Arrangements will be confirmed by the Hall of Fame & Stadium Tours group sales team.

Our catering company, Delaware North, has a strict ten (10) business-day deadline to confirm final guaranteed numbers. If your payment is not received by that deadline, you will be charged an additional \$10 per guest, per day.

Outside food and beverages are not permitted inside Lambeau Field.
